Pax Lighting's fixtures combine luxury finishes and modern forms with hints that tie them back to their small-town upbringing - earthy terracotta, clean connections, and honest details. Each piece is made by hand in their studio with custom components and finishes made in-house or sourced from locations around Nebraska.

"We've found that our Nebraska manufacturing partners have so much to offer. Plus, a huge part of our business is excellent customer service. We really do care for our clients and love seeing their projects succeed. Who better to take care of them than a community of genuinely nice, big-hearted Midwesterners?" explains Nordhues.



Pax Lighting's pieces will be on display at the MADE section of the show in booth M820. Now in its 18th year, the Architectural Digest Design Show draws in approximately 40,000 attendees and over 400 exhibitors in 4 featured areas. The MADE section of the show is a juried exhibition of handcrafted or limited edition furnishing, accessories, and art.
